# Camp Life

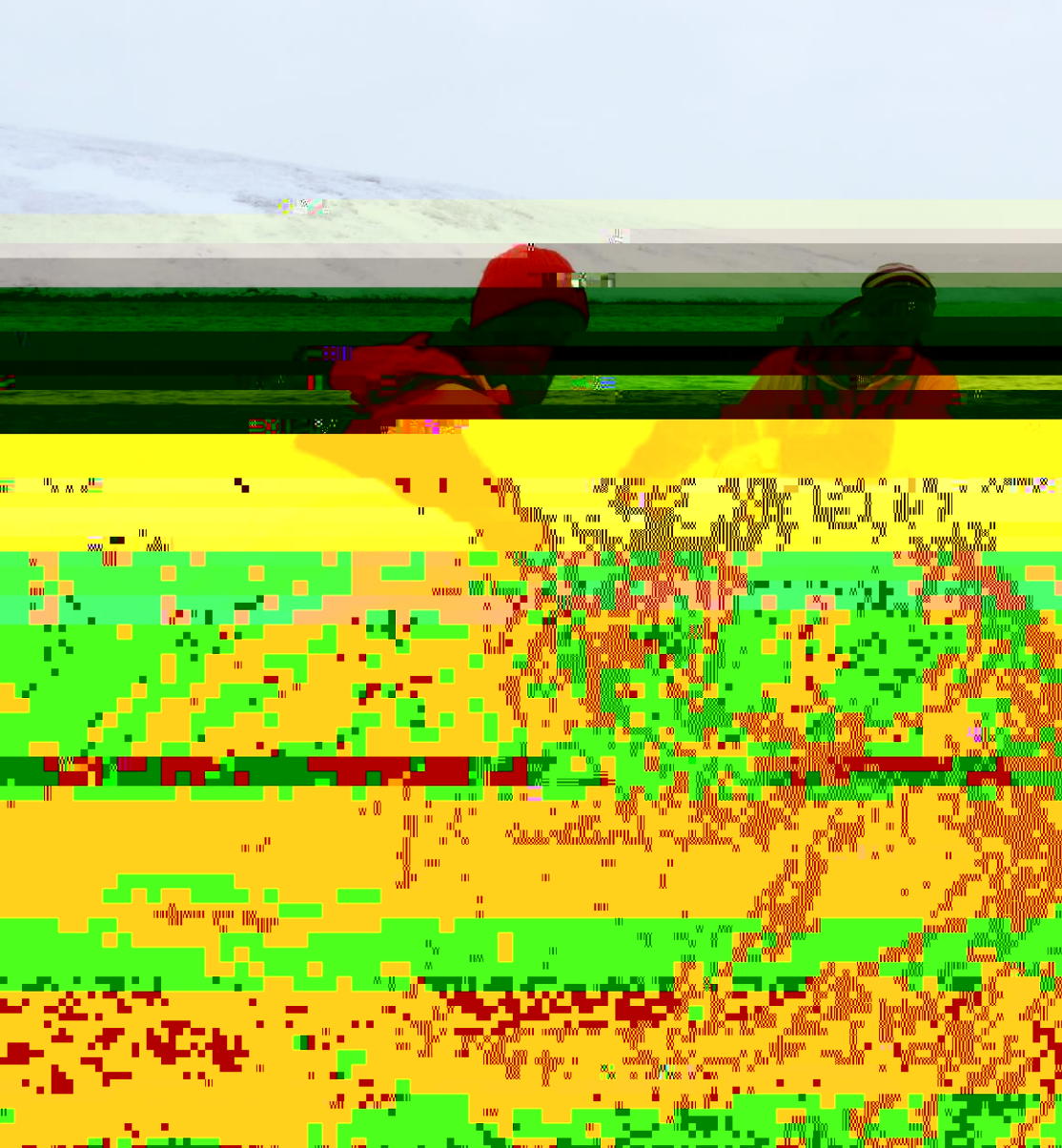
- Amazing food as always
